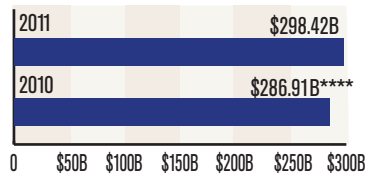


A CLOSER LOOK

National giving continues to grow

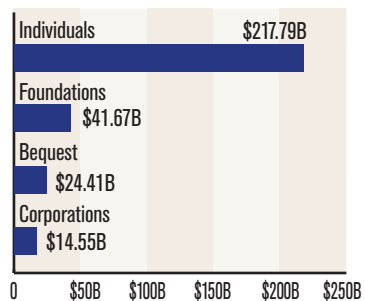
Total charitable giving across the county grew by 4 percent in 2011 from 2010 as donations increased to \$298.42 billion. Giving by individuals increased by 2.8 percent in 2011, compared to corporations, which saw a 4.9 percent decline.

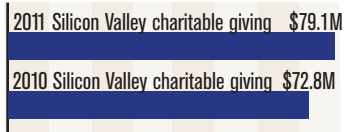

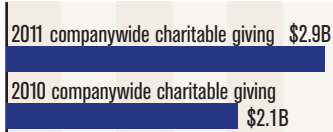
A CLOSER LOOK

Increased giving locally and companywide

Cash given to charitable organizations in Silicon Valley saw an 8.7 percent rise among the top 50 companies on the list this year compared with last year. There was also a 38.1 percent increase in companywide giving.
